Vineyard and Region: Cahors, South-West France.

Grape Variety: 100% Malbec.

Terroir: Clayey-calcareous and siliceous soil of the 2nd and 3rd terraces.

Work of the vine and winemaking: Certification: High Environmental Value. Environmentally friendly and traditional methods of working of the vines. Harvested early in the morning; a press and bled rosé.

Tasting Notes: Vibrant pink in color; fruity Malbec displaying aromas of lime zest, strawberries and notes of spices; lively texture with a round and supple palate; an excellent fruity aftertaste.

Food Pairing: Perfect on its own or paired with food. Serve it with poultry, charcuterie or barbecues. Best enjoyed fresh.
