Jean-Luc Baldès, a recognized Malbec specialist, extends to you a personal invitation to discover an original French Malbec. Dashing, Petit Clos is a fruity and full-bodied wine. Perfectly accessible young but a 5 years of aging will reveal its true fullness.

Vineyard and Region: Cahors, South-West France.

Grape Variety: 85% Malbec, 15% Merlot.

Terroir: The most beautiful 2nd terrace of the estate; red clayey-calcareous soil.

Work of the vine and winemaking: Certification: High Environmental Value. Environmentally friendly and traditional methods of working. No oak, pure fruit.

Tasting Notes: Fresh and pure nose, displaying expressive flavors of red fruits and plums. Subtle texture, good density of fruits. Well integrated tannins with sweet spiciness. Petit Clos is a juicy and attractive wine with good and fresh length.

Food Pairing: Ideal with traditional dishes such as ham, steak and cheeses. After 2-3 years of aging Petit Clos will reveal its fullness. Also serve it with mushrooms, red meats, game and cheeses.
